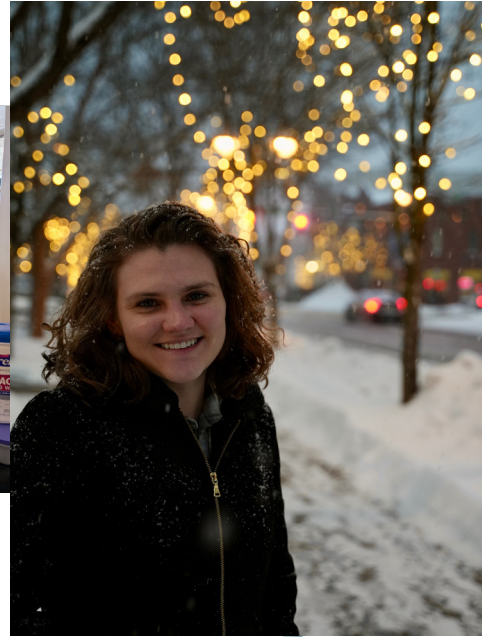

LANDMARKS



BLACK COVERED BRIDGE

Known as one of the longest and few remaining covered bridges in southwest Ohio, and on its original site, the Black Covered Bridge is a must see landmark in Oxford, Ohio. Restored in 2000, this location is preserved by the Oxford Museum Association featuring a State of Ohio Bicentennial Historic Marker on site.



"CHANGEMAKERS OF OXFORD" MURAL

Rehomed at the municipal building of Oxford, this mural honors local leaders who have made a lasting impact on the community and beyond. With vibrant portraits and bold colors, this mural highlights individual changemakers who have advanced equity, education, and civic engagement in Oxford.



OXFORDS BEE HIVE MURAL

Take a selfie at this massive double-sided alley mural by artist, Joe Prescher. Funded by donations from the community, this mural was inspired by locals and students. Joe encouraged those who walked by to paint the "honey" inside the honeycombs. Each bee has a unique symbol or namesake of someone in the community found in the heart of Uptown.

DID YOU KNOW?

Oxford is full of iconic landmarks that reflect its rich history and vibrant culture. Snap a photo beneath the beloved Oxford Town Clock, stroll across the scenic Black Covered Bridge, or admire the "Changemakers of Oxford" mural, celebrating influential community members. While you're here, don't miss the massive "The Oxford Hive" also found Uptown and vibrant foxes mural at Peffer Park—local favorites for mural lovers. History buff? There's many preserved places in Oxford to see! Step back in time at the DeWitt Log Cabin, a preserved piece of 1800s frontier life. Nature inspired? Take a peaceful walk through the Miami University Formal Gardens, a picturesque retreat year-round behind the Marcum Hotel & Conference Center.



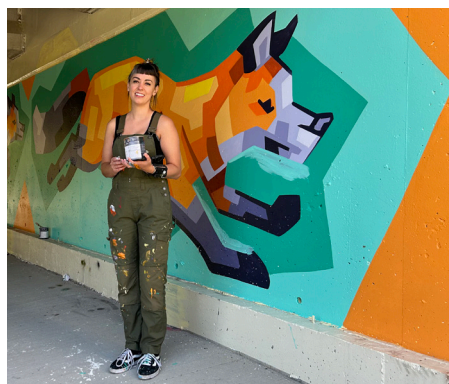
OXFORD TOWN CLOCK

A beloved symbol, the Oxford Town Clock stands proudly in the heart of Uptown. With its classic design and prominent location in front of Brick Street, it has kept time—and tradition—for generations. Stop by to view this iconic clock as a timeless landmark to life in Oxford.



DEWITT LOG HOMESTEAD

Take a glimpse into the 19th-century frontier life, built in the early 1800s, it is now the oldest remaining structure in Oxford township. DeWitt cabin reflects early settler history and serves as a hands-on educational site managed by the Oxford Museum Association in the summer and for events like Hike-A-Thon.



FOXES MURAL

Discover this woodland secret at Peffer Park, the Fox Mural created by Oxford native, Hannah Webb (AKA The Obanoth), is a vibrant tribute to Oxford's natural wildlife. Nestled under the overpass of the Oxford Area Trails, this large-scale mural features a leash of foxes running under the bridge is a new favorite for art mural enthusiasts.



LEGENDS & LORE MARKER

Harry Sylvester Thobe was a master mason who came to Oxford in 1895, creating notable works such as Miami University's Thobe Fountain and his home, "Sunset Place." He was also a legendary local sports superfan, famously cheering the Reds and Miami University with his iconic unmatched flair and devotion.

DIVE INTO *cultural experiences*

Oxford, Ohio is rich in cultural experiences that celebrate both its artistic spirit and deep historical roots. The Oxford Community Arts Center (OCAC), located in the historic Oxford Female Institute building, serves as a vibrant hub for creativity—offering art exhibitions, performances, classes, and studio space for local artists. Each summer, the OCAC and Enjoy Oxford host Shakespeare in the Park, a free outdoor event that brings live theater to the community in collaboration with the Cincinnati Shakespeare Company. Nearby, stop in to visit the William H. McGuffey House and Museum, a National Historic Landmark on Miami University's campus preserving the legacy of McGuffey's Readers and offers insight to 19th-century education and life in Ohio.

Historical exploration continues through the "Oxford, Ohio Black History Tour", a self-guided walking tour that highlights significant Black heritage sites such as Bethel A.M.E. Church and the Freedom Summer Memorial. The tour brings attention to the lives and contributions of Black community members throughout Oxford's history. Additionally, the Oxford Museum Association (OMA) preserves rural 19th-century life through the Doty and DeWitt Homesteads—two historic homes that are open to the public (weekends from Memorial Day through Labor Day) and hosts annual events like the Apple Butter Festival and the Arts & Crafts Fair. Together, these cultural experiences reflect Oxford's ongoing commitment to honoring its past while fostering a strong sense of community and creativity.

OXFORD BLACK HISTORY TOUR

Take this self-guided walking tour developed by Enjoy Oxford, to highlight 19 significant sites that commemorate the contributions and experiences of Black residents in the area. Notable stops include the Bethel A.M.E. Church, one of Oxford's oldest Black congregations, and the Freedom Summer Memorial found on Miami University's Western Campus, honors the three civil rights workers who trained there in 1964 before losing their lives in Mississippi.

SHAKESPEARE IN THE PARK

This free outdoor performance features the Cincinnati Shakespeare Company presenting one of Shakespeare's timeless plays in the OCAC's outdoor pavilion.



OXFORD COMMUNITY ARTS CENTER

A cornerstone for the city's artistic endeavors. Housed in the historic Oxford Female Institute building, established in 1849. After serving various roles, including as a women's dormitory, known famously as the school for first lady Caroline Scott Harrison, the center has evolved from an educational institution for women into a vibrant community arts hub.



CENTER FOR PERFORMING ARTS

Enjoy hundreds of theatre and musical productions fostering multicultural and multigenerational heritage to the Oxford area. Inside, two performance halls of the Center for Performing Arts house upcoming recitals, art installations, instrumental performances, virtual productions, festivals and more!



MCGUFFEY HOUSE & MUSEUM

Tour the historic William H. McGuffey House and Museum located on Miami University's campus. Built in 1833, this Federal-style brick house was the residence of William Holmes McGuffey, a professor at Miami University and the author of the McGuffey Readers, a series of educational books that shaped American public education in the 19th century.

Feeling your best outdoors? Oxford's got...a lot of it! For the avid hiker, runner, or just relaxer, we can find you the best spot to recharge and refresh. Oxford is full of great outdoor spots to explore. Walk, run, or bike the scenic Oxford Area Trails, or unwind in nature at Ruder Preserve, Silvoor Sanctuary, and the Miami University Natural Areas. Nearby, the MetroParks offer even more ways to play outside, and Peffer Park is perfect for relaxing, hiking, or having a picnic. However you enjoy the outdoors, you'll find it here.



Oxford Area Trails

Take a stroll on Oxford's multi-use paths that connect our community to healthier lifestyles, and take in the surroundings of nature on a paved path to historical landmarks, scenery, parks, and more. Eventually, the trail will connect the fabric of surrounding neighborhoods and enhance the quality of community living surrounding the city of Oxford. Look out for Oxford's newest race on the trails, the O.A.T.S. & Honey 5K/10K established in 2025, it will be held yearly in the spring before the Oxford Bee Festival.

Miami University Natural Area Trails

The Miami University Natural Areas offer over 1,000 acres of forests, streams, and meadows with more than 17 miles of scenic hiking trails. With several trailheads it's easy to find your way into the woods for a quick walk or a wandering adventure.

Disc Golf

Take on the 18 hole course through the hills and woods on Miami University's Western Campus (download course sheet online).

Helen Ruder Preserve

This peaceful, tucked-away spot near Yager Stadium is ideal for a quiet stroll for all ages and abilities. The Ruder Preserve is divided into two sides; a short loop trail winding through woods and wetlands, and the other connecting to the Bachelor Preserve trailhead. It's a great place to find wildflowers, birdwatching, and the babbling sounds of Four Mile Creek. It's small but full of charm—ideal for a quick dose of forest bathing with built-in benches and resting spots.

30 YEARS TREE CITY USA IN OXFORD

Oxford, Ohio has proudly been recognized as a Tree City USA for 30 consecutive years, a distinction that reflects the community's long-standing commitment to environmental stewardship and urban forestry. This designation honors Oxford's dedication to maintaining healthy tree cover through thoughtful planning, regular tree care, and community engagement. From shaded neighborhoods and scenic parks to its walkable, tree-lined streets, Oxford's urban forest enhances quality of life, supports local ecosystems, and reinforces the city's identity as a welcoming, sustainable college town. Three decades of Tree City USA recognition underscores Oxford's ongoing investment in preserving its natural beauty for residents, students, and visitors alike.

Silvoor Biological Sanctuary

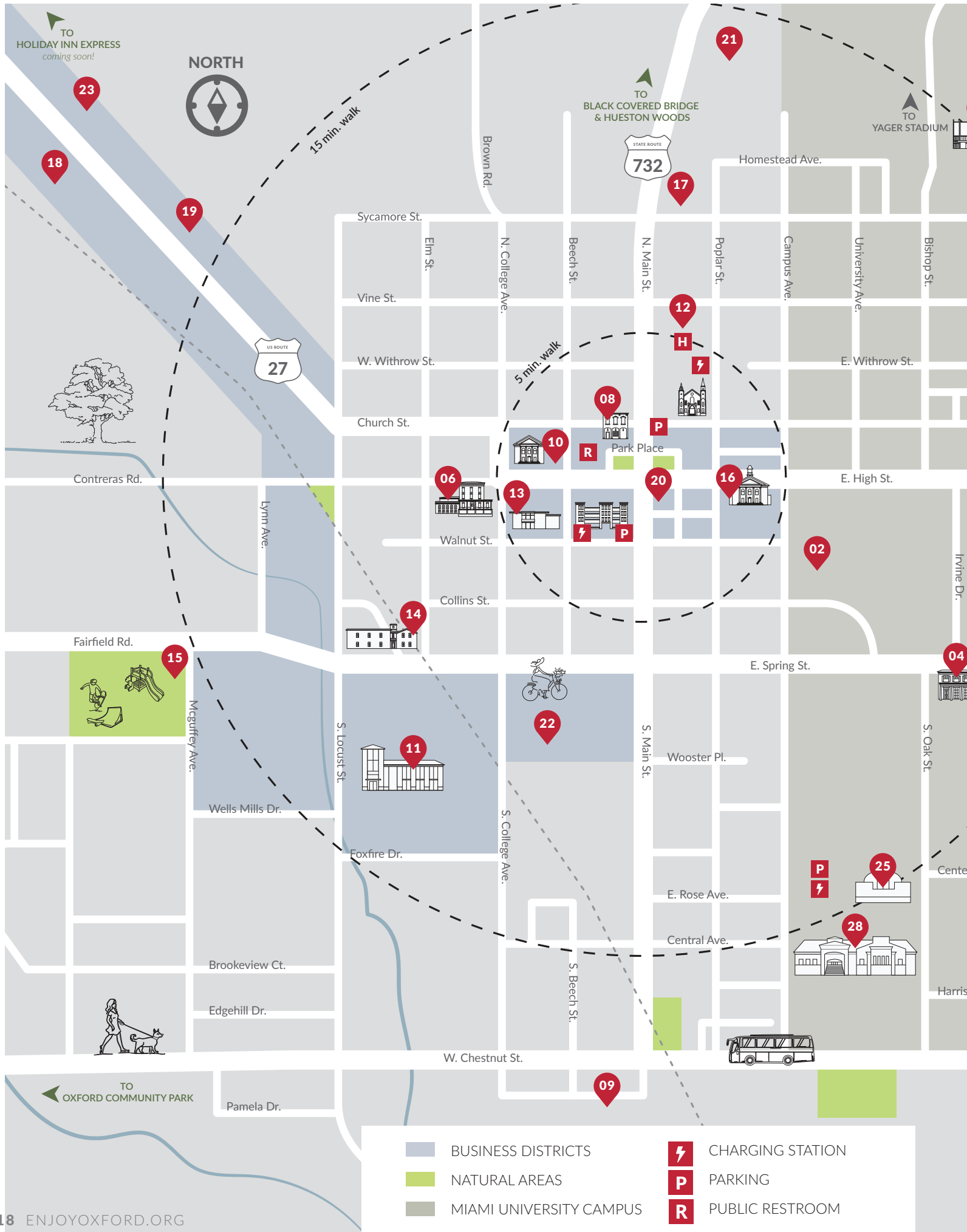
This five-acre preserve was transformed in the 1930s by Miami University zoology professor Dr. Robert A. Hefner and his family into a thriving natural habitat. Today, it boasts over 60 species of native wildflowers, a short loop trail, and a peaceful stream. Each spring, the sanctuary hosts guided Wildflower Walks led by Miami University botanists, offering visitors a chance to learn about local flora and enjoy the seasonal blooms.

MetroParks of Butler County

Just south of town, Indian Creek MetroPark features wooded trails, creek access, a playground, and picnic shelters—ideal for hiking, birdwatching, or a relaxing afternoon outdoors. Nearby, Mill Race Preserve MetroPark offers two miles of scenic trails through meadows and along Four Mile Creek, accessible via the Oxford Area Trail System. These parks provide a peaceful escape into nature, all within a short drive or bike ride from Uptown Oxford.

Oxford Aquatic Center & Community Park

A summer favorite for families and visitors. This award-winning facility features a zero-depth entry pool with a kiddie area, water slides, a lazy river, water basketball, and an 8-lane competition pool with diving boards. The surrounding park offers a variety of amenities, including lighted ball diamonds, playgrounds, walking paths, ball courts, and natural areas, making it a perfect spot for recreation and relaxation for all ages.

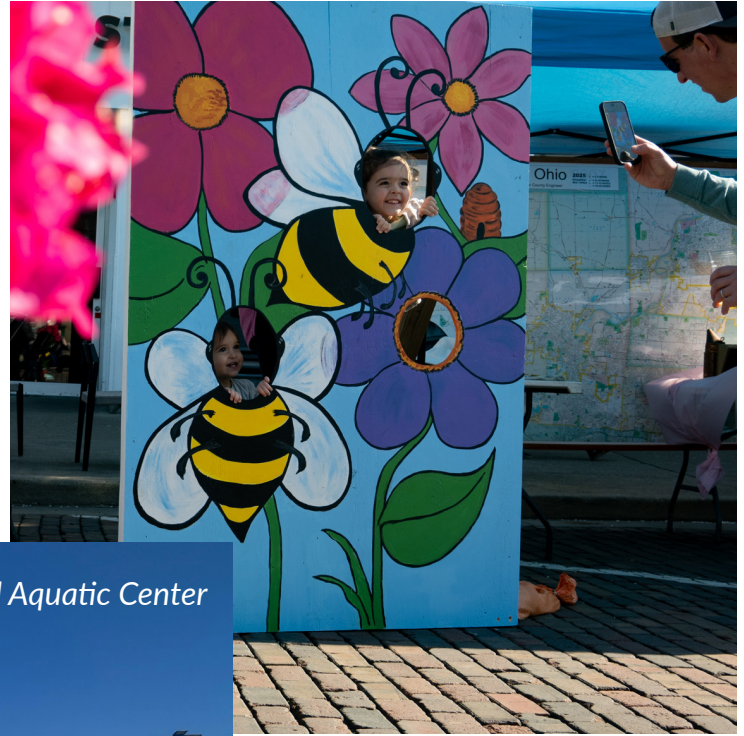
